



2011 Dealer Information

Location: The 2011 Gamers Reunion gaming convention will be held in the Rochester Senior Center, **April 29-May 1, 2011**. The address is as follows:

Dealer Booth Cost: Dealer booths cost \$50 per table. Multiple tables may be rented, but please contact Gamers Reunion first to make sure there will be room in the layout for the number of tables you want to combine together.

Dealer Booth Includes: 1 eight foot table, badges as described below, and 2 chairs. Requests for an electrical outlet should be made in advance; spaces near electrical outlets are limited. Extra badges can be purchased for additional fees.

Sharing Booths: Gamers Reunion fully understands the potential need and desire to share a booth with another dealer. Any dealer operating out of a booth must be approved by the Gamers Reunion staff ahead of time. Gamers Reunion also requests that one dealer be identified as the primary dealer to handle payment inquiries, badge distribution, and questions concerning the booth rental. Sharing a booth will not entitle a dealer to additional badges unless paid for as described below.

Badges: Each dealer order comes with 1 badge per table plus one extra badge (1 table: 2 badges, 2 tables: 3 badges, etc...). All badges allow full access to the convention. Additional badges can be purchased for \$10 each. ***Please submit names, addresses, badge names, and email addresses no later than March 13, 2011.*** The earlier the better, as the information will be entered into our registration database and badge holders will be able to preregister for events online for times they are not assisting with the booth.

Internet: We do not guarantee Internet access at our current location.

Deadlines: In order to reserve your dealer space, Gamers Reunion requires a ***50% deposit payment within two weeks of requesting space.*** If a deposit payment is not received within two weeks the space will be released and reassigned on a first come, first serve basis. ***Final payment is due on or before March 13, 2011.*** If the final payment is not received on or before March 13, 2011, the dealer space will be reassigned on a first come, first serve basis.

Payment: Gamers Reunion prefers payment via PayPal at this email address: prereg@gamersreunion.com. If you need to make arrangements for a different payment option please contact info@gamersreunion.com.

Refunds: A refund of the initial payment will only be available after Gamers Reunion has taken place and only if the space was re-purchased. If the dealer space was not re-purchased, all deposit payments will be forfeited.

Hotel Rooms: We recommend staying at the Days Inn Downtown Rochester, Holiday Inn Express, or The Kahler Grand Hotel. These are the 3 closest locations to the convention site. Days Inn is a block away from the convention area, but they fill up quickly.

Dealer Hours: Dealer tables should be occupied at all times during the following hours of operation. Dealers may extend their hours to include any normal convention hours, or they may shut down outside of the hours of operation to relax and enjoy the convention as a guest.

Friday – 5PM – 9PM
Saturday – 10AM – 8PM
Sunday – 10AM – 4PM

Convention Hours: The following is a list of convention hours:

Friday – 3PM – 12AM
Saturday – 8AM – 12AM
Sunday – 9AM – 6PM

Dealers are welcome to participate in gaming activities when not manning a booth.

Dealers will have access to setup their booths 1 hour prior to the start of the convention on Friday.

Security: Gamers Reunion will have 2 floor walkers in the convention area during all normal convention hours to not only assist convention goers but to discourage loss and vandalism; however Gamers Reunion is not responsible for property loss, so please arrange your booth to discourage shoplifting. We strongly encourage all dealers to take reasonable precautions to prevent theft and damages. If an incident does occur, please inform a Gamers Reunion staff member immediately. Gamers Reunion would also like to point out that the dealer area is on the perimeter of the gaming area. If you close your booth before the end of the days convention hours we strongly recommend packing up your most valuable merchandise and cash drawer and taking them with you. When the convention is done for the day, the convention area will be locked and the alarm system set until the staff arrives the next morning.

Signs/Banners: All signs and banners a dealer utilizes must fit within the confines of their respective dealer space. Any tape that will peel or destroy wallpaper may not be used and such destruction will result in a fine as determined by the Rochester Senior Center, payable by the dealer.
